Can you please introduce your company?

The production activity of STAMPLAST SRL began in 1989, a company of the PIBER group. The production of articles in plastic material, mostly in polypropylene, consists of:

- Trays and lids for food packaging, ice cream, dessert, gastronomic products and various other items.
- The activity of STAMPLAST SRL within the Group is to transform, on behalf of Pibergroup, the customer's requests into finished products. The complementary nature of Stamplast and Piberplast processes, allow us to respond to market needs even in the event of production difficulties of one of the two companies (production surplus, temporary equipment failures, etc.) The transformation from raw material into finished product takes place using injection presses and, when required, decorating the product using the IML and sleeving technique. The most important customers divided by type of product are:
- Ice creams: Sammontana, Froneri, Eskigel, G7;
 - Dessert: Dolcissimo Srl – Solo Italia, A-27
 - Dairy products: Lactalis Group, Sterilgarda, Piber Espana, Granarolo of course, equally important customers must be added to these.

The staff employed is approximately 130 units. The production is spread over three working shifts seven days a week. STAMPLAST obtained the certification of its Quality System, according to the UNI EN ISO 9002 standard, in January 1998, in 2002 it obtained the transition to the ISO 9001:2000, in 2009 the transition to the ISO 9001:2008 until last December 2016 with the passage to the current revision of 2015.

Why did you choose the BRCGS Standard?

In 2006 Stamplast obtained the certification according to the BRC / IOP Standard reconfirmed from year to year until today according to the BRCGS Global Standard for Packaging Materials. The purpose of Stamplast is to use this Standard as a tool to implement a hygiene management system and develop a solid path of QUALITY AND FOOD SAFETY CULTURE. The type of product supplied is primary packaging in direct contact with food in the sector of rigid plastic forming and printing processes. In 2020-2021, again in order to guarantee the sustainability requirements of its products, Stamplast is certified according to the SMETA 4 Pillars requirements and the new ISCC PLUS standard, International Sustainability & Carbon Certification, which allows companies in the supply chain to monitor and demonstrate the sustainability of their products through the control of sustainability, traceability and mass balance requirements of the entire system.

What are the benefits being BRCGS certificated?

The benefits being BRCGS certificated are to reach all over the world market (being a GFSI standard) and to demonstrate to the final consumer the importance for hygiene and for food quality.
